Writing Contest Rules

Details

Category:	Short story or imaginary magazine article
Word Limit:	2,000 words
Style:	12 pt type, double-spaced
File format:	Word (doc, docx)
Title:	Provide a title, but no author for blind evaluation
Deadline:	September 1, 2018
Restriction:	Must be original unpublished work
Eligibility:	Open to all adults 18 years and older

Awards and Recognition:

First Place: \$1,000 ~ Second Place: \$250 ~ Third Place: \$100

Winners will be recognized and asked to read their stories on October 20, 2018 at the Awards Festival. Winning stories will be posted on the Jack London State Historic Park website with an interview with the author.

Entry Fee:

\$20.00 per entry (Jack London Park members); \$35 nonmembers. Entry fee to be paid online at time of submission. Writers may submit multiple entries, each with a separate entry fee.

How to Enter the Contest

 1. Subject line should read: 2018 Fiction Contest Submission.
 2. Body of email must state manuscript title, author's name, phone number, email address, and assurance that the story has not appeared in print or online media.
 3. Submission is to be an Attachment and must not include the author's name on the manuscript.
- Payment must be made online below, concurrent with your email entry, by September 1, 2018. Email addresses and names on your entry and payment must match.
- The deadline is absolute; no exceptions. Failure to comply with the Details above will result in disqualification.
